Develop and create content including writing, shooting video, and editing into segments for use throughout district. Research, write, and manage \$150,000 annual grant dedicated to purchasing video equipment for the district studio and individual school studios. Produce live sports events (20 local events as well as~70 additional games for WIAA state basketball and football championships series. Fill dedicated district cable channel with news, talk shows, informational programming, live sports, live concert performances, and compilations that edit disparate school-produced content into palatable block of programming. Develop content calendars, work with various departments that contribute content, and architect production calendar accordingly. Oversee shooting, video editing, story ideation, script writing, post-production, motion graphics creation, image creation, coding live sports graphics using HTML, CSS, and JavaScript.

- Led first-ever student-led broadcast in U.S. of state title games by recruiting / training students on WIAA video productions; students gained hands-on experience working with multiple cameras, announcers, graphics, instant replay, and high-quality video, with most recent basketball tournament received >250,000 views.
- Upgraded entire school district to high-definition equipment in 5 years to completely replace obsolete technologies; used multi-year plan charting path forward to future-proof studios and equipment caches while providing students access to new equipment.
- Won 1 Emmy Award and nominated for total of 6 Emmys for using video to highlight employee excellence via teacher-hosted / produced shows showcasing their particular areas of expertise.
- Engineered shift from traditional cable-based to online framework by moving away from 30-min. long-form programs to shorter, web-friendly content and by expanding live streaming efforts to primarily focus on storytelling web videos reaching larger audiences.
